Last year, **31,654** community members received services from one or more of our United Way agencies in Gordon County. Over **520** victims of domestic violence were provided with shelter, advocacy, and support. **342** individuals were provided financial assistance. Over **7,100** children were positively impacted by either having a safe place to go after school, attending camp, or being able to



participate in leadership building activities such as scouting and 4-H. Finally, almost **24,000** services were provided to over **2,300** individuals including hot meals, prevention of eviction or loss of utilities, emergency shelter and much more.
